Onwave UK Limited is committed to achieving Net Zero emissions by 2050.

Baseline Emissions Footprint

Additional Details relating to the Baseline Emissions calculations.	
2020 has been selected as the baseline year for Onwave's carbon footprint reporting. The baseline represents the earliest year for which sufficient emissions data was available across Scope 1, Scope 2 and Scope 3 categories. The 2020 baseline will be used as the reference point for monitoring changes in emissions and measuring progress in reducing Onwave's carbon footprint.

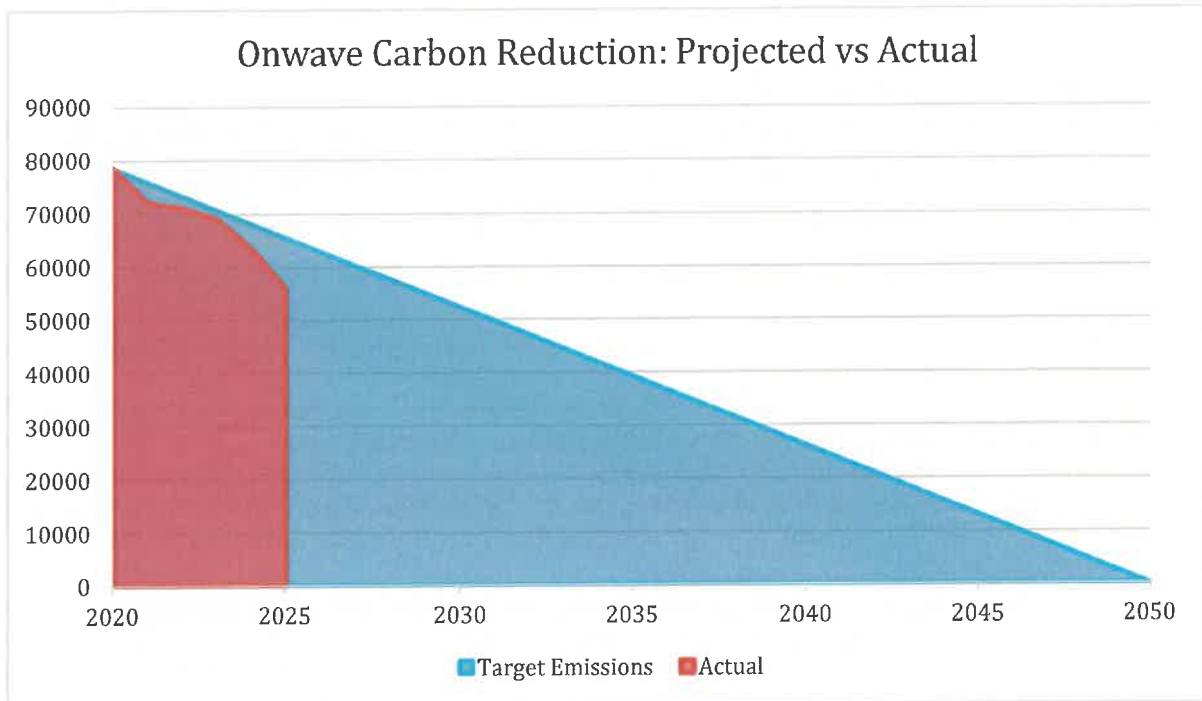

Emissions reduction targets

In order to continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets.

We project that carbon emissions will decrease over the next five years to **52.381 tCO₂e by 2030**. This is a reduction of **6%**.

Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives

The following environmental management measures and projects have been completed or implemented since the **2020** baseline. The carbon emission reduction achieved by these schemes equate to **22.767 tCO₂e**, a **29%** reduction against the **2020** baseline and the measures will be in effect when performing the contract.

Onwave has implemented a number of measures to support the reduction of its environmental impact, including:

- Achieved ISO 14001 Environmental Management System certification in May 2022, successfully recertified in 2026, and committed to maintaining the accreditation through continual improvement of our Environmental Management System.
- Monitoring Scope 1, Scope 2 and Scope 3 emissions.
- Monitoring electricity, gas, fuel, water and waste usage.

- Carrying out a packaging review and using reusable flight cases for hardware where possible, reducing packaging waste.
- Moving to a more environmentally friendly head office with energy-saving features such as motion-sensor lighting.
- Increasing recycling and reducing waste sent to landfill.
- Using DPD as a delivery partner, supporting lower-carbon deliveries through their growing electric vehicle fleet.
- Introducing an electric vehicle scheme and cycle-to-work scheme for employees.
- Increasing the use of digital documents and electronic processes to reduce paper use.
- Regularly reviewing environmental performance and improvement opportunities.

Future carbon reduction initiatives

Onwave intends to continue reducing its carbon emissions through:

- Encouraging rail travel by providing rail cards to employees.
- Working with the landlord to reduce energy consumption within the building.
- Continuing to increase recycling and reduce waste sent to landfill.
- Undertaking an EcoVadis assessment.
- Working with suppliers to identify opportunities to reduce Scope 3 emissions.
- Using rail for overseas travel where practical, ahead of air travel.
- Progressively replacing the current vehicle fleet with electric vehicles.
- Continuing to improve environmental performance through the ISO 14001 Environmental Management System.

Declaration and Sign Off

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with PPN 006 and associated guidance and reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans.

Emissions have been reported and recorded in accordance with the published reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans and the GHG Reporting Protocol corporate standard³ and uses the appropriate Government emission conversion factors for greenhouse gas company reporting⁴.
